Our Approach to Health & Safety - Safe Mission.

Our approach to ensuring H&S from our activities is set out in our Territorial H&S policy SM01 available on our Net Consent policy management software.

In summary our objectives are:

- · to undertake the mission of The Salvation Army in a safe way, so far as is reasonably practicable. The mission first. Safety always.
- to plan our activities, pre-empt foreseeable risks and take steps to prevent or reduce them.
- · to provide and maintain safe and healthy environment for our employees, volunteers, contractors, and members of the public.
- to provide and maintain safe plant and equipment.
- to ensure safe use, storage, and handling of hazardous substances.
- to comply with all relevant applicable legal, contractual and other requirements
- · to provide appropriate information, through various internal communication systems, instruction, and supervision of employees and volunteers.

- to ensure that officers, employees and volunteers are competent to do the tasks that they are appointed to do and are given adequate training where necessary.
- to prevent injury and cases of ill health from mission activities.

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• to consult with employees on matters affecting their safety and health.

to review our policy and the arrangements for implementing it at regular intervals, with a view to the continual improvement of health and safety management and performance.
